MENTORS comprehensive work ready development program provides students ages 14 to 21 a step-by-step approach to career decision making so they can be their own CAREER CHAMPION.

- ◆ OVR funding is available for students with an IEP or 504 plan
- ◆ Students without an IEP or 504 plan can attend for a negotiated collaboration fee
- ◆ Students who complete class requirements earn a hand held tablet



CHOOSE FROM THE FOLLOWING SERVICES

Pre-Employment Group Instruction (ages 14 – 21):

- ◆ Successful students can earn a hand held tablet.
- ◆ This classroom facilitated, on-line, e-mentoring style training is an accredited program. Students experience workplace readiness training and an introduction to various career options with a specific focus on high demand STEM and Skilled Trades careers.
- ◆ School and Community based delivery options to choose from.
- ◆ Minimum student requirements for school and community groups.

Workplace Learning Experiences (second year students to graduation):

Successful students gain job experience in a temporary or summer position. MENTORS Career Counselors work one-on-one with students to assess, prepare, and assist them with gaining employment opportunities.
